

TRANSITION FROM ALL-REMOTE TO HYBRID LEARNING

WE are excited to welcome your child back to the school building in our Hybrid Learning Model! A few friendly reminders about what to expect:

Your child will have the same teacher(s) who will now teach in-person learners and remote learners simultaneously. This will mean:

- ✓ Teachers now must wear masks while they are teaching and moving about the building.
- ✓ Students attending in person must wear masks:
 - All times
 - At bus stops and on buses
 - In the hallway
 - In the cafeteria/APR (once seated and physically eating mask will be removed)
 - Going to, and in, the restroom
 - In classrooms
- ✓ Patience will be key for everyone's success.
- ✓ The pace of learning will likely slow a bit as everyone adjusts to the new format.

All staff and all students on the hybrid plan MUST screen at home before leaving for school every day. This will mean:

- ✓ The [screening checklist](#) must be completed **daily**.
- ✓ Anyone who is ill must stay home and should contact their healthcare provider for additional guidance.

Any student or staff member exhibiting possible symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent to the nurse's office, monitored and isolated until mandatorily leaving the building to seek medical attention. Any positive report of a case of COVID-19 for a student will immediately be reported to the school nurse, who will notify the Camden County Department of Health, which will guide next steps. Any positive report of a case of COVID-19 for a staff member will immediately be reported to the Human Resources Department, to Keila Rosado or Nancy Adrian, who will notify the Camden County Department of Health, which will guide next steps. This will mean:

- ✓ Families may be notified by the Camden County Department of Health that their student must quarantine at home; family members may be required to quarantine as well.
- ✓ Students ordered by the Department of Health to quarantine will not be allowed in any school buildings until the student's quarantine is lifted.
- ✓ Staff members ordered by the Department of Health to quarantine will not be allowed in any school buildings until the staff member's quarantine is lifted.
