Kindergarten& 1st Grade In-Person Registration Begins 1/16/24

For your planning purposes: In-person kindergarten and 1st grade

registration, for children entering public or private school for the first time, begins January 16, 2024 at the Lewis Administration Building, 45 Ranoldo Terrace. Dates and times are as follows: January 16-19, 8:30 am-2 pm: January 23, 25, 26 and 31, 8:30 am-2 pm; January 30, noon-7 pm; and January 31, 8:30 am-2 pm. Students must be five years old on or before October 1, 2024, to be eligible for kindergarten. Beginning January 1, 2024, please go on the <u>District website</u> to begin the online pre-registration process for the 2024-2025 school year. Detailed registration information and the pre-registration link can be found directly on the <u>District website</u> or by calling (856) 429-5600, x4429. Only the student's legal guardian may register a student for school. It is not necessary to bring your child with you to registration. Please allow one hour to complete the process and bring ALL required documentation with you for registration.
